

# PARKING AT NORTHWEST HOSPITAL & MEDICAL CENTER

The parking program at Northwest Hospital & Medical Center was introduced to make parking both faster and more accessible to our patients and visitors. The program helps ensure patients and visitors will find parking on campus that is convenient to their hospital destination.

Parking kiosks at the main entrance make it easy to ask for directions and provide an additional level of security at the hospital.

The hospital provides a grace period of 29 minutes to allow for visitors to drop off or pick up family and friends. For those visiting our campus for scheduled appointments or to visit for longer periods of time, the rates published on the back of this brochure apply.

Some physician offices and clinics provide validation at no charge. Please check with your physician or clinic directly **before** arriving on campus to see if they validate parking.

## QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

**Q: How does the parking program work?**

**A:** It's simple. Take a ticket from the ticket machine as you enter the campus and continue on to the parking areas nearest your destination. Campus maps, which also indicate patient and visitor parking areas, can be obtained at the front gate and at various locations around campus. When you leave the campus, just hand your ticket and payment to the attendant in the parking kiosk. Your payment can be made by cash, check, or with a debit/credit card.

**Q: Why does Northwest Hospital & Medical Center charge for parking?**

**A:** The Northwest Hospital & Medical Center parking program ensures that patients and visitors receive priority parking for faster, more convenient access to hospital destinations.

The fees collected by the hospital through the parking program cover several local parking taxes. A comprehensive evaluation of other health care facilities in the Seattle area has found that our rates compare favorably to these other local hospitals.

**Q: How can I get to and from Northwest Hospital & Medical Center, if I don't want to park my car on campus?**

**A:** Northwest Hospital has worked with King County to provide excellent bus service to and from the campus. Currently, the Metro Route 345 provides direct campus service, dropping patients and visitors off at the entrance to the main hospital tower. **Q: Are there times when I can park on campus for no charge?**

**A:** Parking on the Northwest Hospital & Medical Center campuses will be free on: weekends, New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

**Q: Is there a similar parking system at the Northwest Outpatient Medical Center (OPMC)?**

**A:** The Northwest Outpatient Medical Center (OPMC) is located south of the hospital at 10330 Meridian Ave N. The parking fees are the same at OPMC, and in effect from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.

## PARKING RATES

Following is a rate schedule for parking on the main Northwest Hospital & Medical Center campus and at the Northwest Outpatient Medical Center.

The rate schedule is in effect on weekdays from 6:00 a.m. to midnight on the main hospital campus, and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Northwest Outpatient Medical Center.

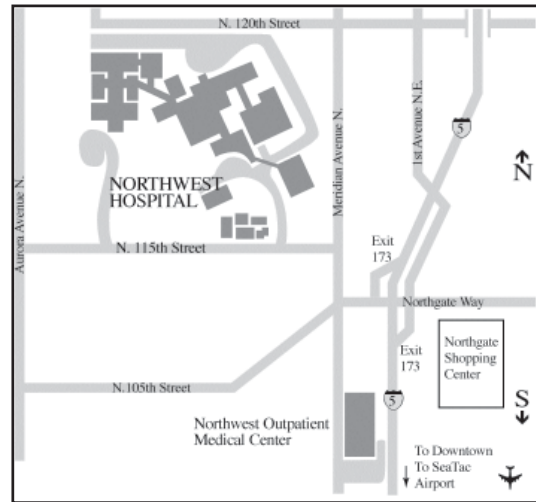

## WHERE TO FIND US



### DIRECTIONS TO NORTHWEST HOSPITAL & MEDICAL CENTER

#### Northbound

(from downtown Seattle, Interstate 90, and State Route 520):

Follow Interstate 5 northbound. Take Exit 173, staying in the left lane. Turn left at the traffic light. At Northgate Way, turn left and follow the road under the freeway for two blocks. Turn right at Meridian Avenue North. Take the first left onto North 115<sup>th</sup> Street. Northwest Hospital is on your right.

#### Southbound

(from Everett, Edmonds, and Interstate 405):

Follow Interstate 5 southbound. Take Exit 173, staying in the right lane. Follow the arrow for Northgate Way westbound. Turn right on Northgate Way and right again at Meridian Avenue north. Take the first left onto North 115<sup>th</sup> Street. Northwest Hospital is on your right.
